What is findhelp?

Findhelp is a community portal that provides Massachusetts residents online access to available resources such as housing, healthcare, early education, and more.

Findhelp will facilitate stronger partnerships across family support providers.

Our hope is that findhelp can be a practical tool that further strengthens SAFE Child Community Initiative partners' work together.

How can findhelp help you serve our communities?

Findhelp offers community-based organizations a way to refer clients to other services and track their success. This platform connects an organization's services with those needing them; helping the organization gain referrals and helping community members access essential services.

How does it work?

Community-based organizations serving Massachusetts will "claim" and update their listings on childrenstrustma.findhelp.com. These organizations populate the site, prompted by an easy-to-use checklist. Staff can then make and receive referrals and will get data on referrals and searches in their region.

Who will findhelp serve?

Everyone in Massachusetts. This site connects you to services and resources to help the families with whom you work. Community members in your area can also connect directly to programs and resources using childrenstrustma.findhelp.com
